Notes for the teacher

These Tests are photocopiable. Test 1: Starter should be given to pupils after they have completed the Starter Unit which revises the language taught in Join In Level 3. Test 2 assesses pupils' learning in Units 1–4, Test 3 in Units 5–7 and Test 4 in Units 8–10.
